



Welcome to Silverwood Elementary TK & Kindergarten!

We are so excited to meet all of our students and their families! The first day of TK and Kindergarten can be a bit scary for both the students and their parents or guardians. We aim to remove the “fear of the unknown” so that the first day is fun filled and exciting for both kids and adults!

- The first day of school is Thursday, August 11th.
- AM students attend school from 8:10-11:40. PM students attend from 10:10-1:45.
- When you get to school, make sure you do NOT pull into or park in the bus circle. You may want to get to school a bit early so that you can find parking on the street. Again, **please do not park or drive through the bus circle.** Please wait at the Kinder gate or on the grass until teachers come out to greet you. Teachers will escort students to their special line up spot on the playground. ALL families must remain behind the gate. The first couple of days may be a little hectic but it will all work out with a little patience! Our number one priority is to keep your child safe.
- If you brought school supplies, we will have bins out for you to place them in. Thank you! If you have a cash donation, please hand directly to a teacher or bring to the office.
- Please provide your child with a healthy breakfast to help begin his or her busy day. For snack or lunch, please include plastic spoons or forks if necessary to eat their meal and remember to write their names on all containers, drinking containers and lunch boxes. All drinking containers MUST be in a drip free container. Backpacks sometimes end up on their sides. Please consider this when selecting a beverage container.
- AM students- Please pack a nutritious snack for your child.
- PM students – Please pack a nutritious lunch for your child.
- If your child goes to day care before or after school, please provide a separate snack and lunch for day care.
- When you pick up your student, please wait outside of the Kindergarten gate until we dismiss your child to you. Our main priority is the safety of your child, so we will not release the students until we know who is picking him/her up. Please be patient as it takes a bit before we recognize parent/guardian faces.
